

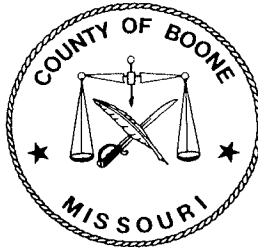

Subject: Extended Leave of Absence without Pay for David Slaughter

The Public Works department requests approval of an **extended leave of absence without pay** in accordance with Boone County Personnel Policy Manual, section 5.7 for David Slaughter, a custodian in position number 517, from June 18 through August 1, 2003. Mr. Slaughter has a serious health condition and was granted Family Medical Leave Act leave which began on March 26, and expires on June 17, 2003. Mr. Slaughter has decided to retire and seek long term disability benefits. The Department has conferred with the County Clerk's Office and they have recommended to the Department and to Mr. Slaughter a retirement date of August 1, 2003 as the best date to coordinate benefits. Mr. Slaughter has agreed to this date. The Department also concurs and is requesting this leave extension to accommodate the recommended retirement date.

The Department also requests authorization to immediately proceed with hiring a permanent replacement for this position in anticipation of Mr. Slaughter's retirement. The Department believes that the position could be filled by the first part of July resulting in an overlap of approximately four weeks.


