#### **SUBJECT: Presentation of Missouri Association of Counties Certificate of Merit**

Commissioner Stamper thanked Auditor June Pitchford for her years of service to Boone County and presented her with the Missouri Association of Counties Certificate of Merit.

#### **SUBJECT: Proposal to Revise of Budget Revision Policy**

Ms. Pitchford stated she annually appraises the performance of her office, asking her staff to identify areas where they have encountered difficulty or areas departments have expressed interest in modifying. The budget revision policy was identified as such an area. Ms. Pitchford outlined her proposal for review.

Commissioner Stamper and Commissioner Miller agreed it is helpful to review internal policies.

#### **SUBJECT: Proposal for Acquisition of Easement**

Public Works Department Right of Way Agent Gloria Gesztesy stated the Department believed it had terminated negotiations with Obermiller/Roemer/Blackfoot Road property owners. One property owner presented a proposal to the Department last night. It is contained in the memorandum to the commission dated April 25, 1996. The individual has since requested additional changes to the proposal. The Department recommends the commission not accept the proposal due to concern that all property owners be treated equitably. Compensation has been based on appraisals obtained by the county. The proposed easement would not provide the county with exclusive control. The property owner would retain control of above ground utilities within the right-of-way. The Department believes that is inappropriate.

In response to a question from Commissioner Miller, Ms. Gesztesy replied there are no overhead utilities there now. He does not want to deal with them in the future. If the county had control of the easement, it could allow overhead utilities.

Mr. Patton commented the point of the County controlling the easement is to avoid paying to relocate utilities in the future. The legal expense savings presented by settling this case is minimal because the remaining properties still have to be condemned.

In response to a question from Commissioner Stamper, Mr. Patton replied the commission could offer a counter proposal. He will probably file the petition Monday or Tuesday of next week.

Ms. Gesztesy stated there were issues in the proposal, such as slopes, which the Department does not object to. The main concern is the difference in compensation. The property owner never really responded to the certified letter from the appraiser. The difference in the amount of money is not great, the problem is equity. The Department would lose integrity by negotiating with the property owners when it adhered to appraisals in negotiations with other property owners.

Commissioner Miller agreed with the recommendation of the Public Works Department.

Following review of the items in the proposal which the Department would agree with, Commissioner Stamper stated he prefers the county hold firm with its original proposal.

## SUBJECT: Presentation of Missouri Association of Counties Certificate of Merit

Commissioner Stamper thanked Sheriff Ted Boehm for his years of service to Boone County and presented him with the Missouri Association of Counties Certificate of Merit.

## SUBJECT: Vote to Authorize Closed Meeting 610.021 (3) RSMo.

Commissioner Miller moved that the County Commission of the County of Boone authorize a closed meeting to immediately follow the regular meeting of the County Commission on April 25, 1996 as authorized by Section 610.021 (3) RSMo. to discuss the hiring, firing, disciplining or promoting of a particular employee by a public governmental body when personal information about the employee is discussed or recorded.

Commissioner Stamper seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. Order 256-96.

# SUBJECT: Agreement with City of Columbia for Health Services at Correctional Facility, On-Site Sewage Program and Community Health Services

Commissioner Miller stated she has satisfied her concerns with the agreement and moved that the County Commission of the County of Boone approve the attached agreement with the City of Columbia for health services at the Correctional Facility, the on-site sewage program and community health services.

Commissioner Stamper seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. Order 257-96.

#### SUBJECT: Community/Social Service Agreement with Planned Parenthood

Commissioner Stamper moved that the County Commission of the County of Boone approve the attached Community/Social Service Agreement with Planned Parenthood of Mid-Missouri, Inc. for funding of their Teen to Teen Theater.

Commissioner Miller seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. Order 258-96.

#### **SUBJECT: Reports from Commissioners**
