SUBJECT: Award Bid 15-11MAR98, Copiers/Faxes-Supplies/Equipment

Purchasing Director Beckie Jackson referred to her memo dated March 30, 1998.

Commissioner Stamper moved that the County Commission of the County of Boone award bid 15-11MAR98 for Copiers/Faxes - Supplies/Equipment, following the recommendations of the Purchasing Department to:

Photocopier #1- to Image Technologies, Inc. for \$7,309.00 including the award of an on-site maintenance for 200,000 copies per year at a cost of \$600.00 per year upon the expiration of the 90-day warranty: including the base machine, add alt #1-duplexing, add alt #2-Automatic Document Feeder, add alt #6-20 bin stapling sorter, add alt #7-3-hold punch feature and add alt #8-2,500 sheet paper tray less a \$300 trade-in value of the existing machine.

Photocopier #2 - to IKON Canon Division for \$8,264.00 including the award of an on-site maintenance for 125,000 copies per year and at a cost of \$625.00 per year upon the expiration of the 90 day warranty: including the base machine, add alt #1-duplexing; add alt #3-automatic reversing document feeder; add alt #6-bin stapling sorter, and add alt #8-2,500 sheet paper tray less a \$800 trade in value of the existing machine.

Facsimile Machine - to DataComm Inc. Panasonic UF 342 w/1 MB Memory Upgrade - \$745.00 plus \$57 for installation: including the 5 years on-site maintenance at a cost of \$120 per year after the expiration of the 1 year warranty period;

noting the attached rejections as outlined by the attached bid tabulation; and authorize the Presiding Commissioner to sign the contracts and disposal forms for fixed asset tab number 08224 Canon NP 6650 II and 7254 Minolta EP4301.
