Subject: Purchasing Department

Melinda Bobbitt, Purchasing Department Director, was present on behalf of these items.

A. Second Reading and Approval of State of Missouri Contract C50194001 (Sagem Morpho Maintenance Agreement)

Commissioner Elkin moved to approve the Sagem Morpho Maintenance Agreement.

The evaluation committee recommends award to Boyce & Bynum Pathology Laboratories per their attached evaluation report.

Also attached, is a spreadsheet of a sample of the highest used lab tests performed during the 2004 fiscal year. We paid \$2,125 in 2004 for this sampling of tests. Based on this bid, for these same tests, we would pay \$4,381 from Labcorp, and \$1,792 from Boyce and Bynum. We will save 16% in 2005 on lab testing at the Boone County Sheriff's department.

This is a term and supply contract that will be paid from department 1255 - Corrections, account 86300 - Testing. \$13,193 remains in this account at this time.

Commissioner Schnarre stated this is a first reading and requested the Deputy County Clerk to schedule this item for a second reading at the next available meeting with an appropriate order for award.
