#### B. First Reading of Bid 56-06SEP05 (Clark Lane Road Improvement Project)

Heather Turner stated the Bid for Clark Lane Road Improvement Project closed on September 6, 2005. Two bids were received. Purchasing and the Public Work's department recommend award to Columbia Curb & Gutter for submitting the low bid.

Total cost of contract is \$149,662.53 with a 10% contingency of \$14,966.25 for a total Purchase Order amount of \$164,628.78. This contract will be paid out of department 2045 – Public Works Design and Construction, account number 71100 – Outside Services. The original budget was \$190,000.00.

#### **Public Comment**

June Pitchford, Boone County Auditor, stated it has been brought to her attention that the IRS has changed the mileage reimbursement from 40.5 ¢ to 48.5 ¢ effective September 1 to December 31, 2005.

The Commission in the past has used the IRS mileage reimbursement rate. This rate is usually set for January 1 to December 31 of each year. This is the first time the IRS has made a change during the middle of a fiscal year.

Mrs. Pitchford asked the Commission how this should be handled.

Commissioner Miller requested reports be done about how many employees receive mileage reimbursement.

Commissioner Schnarre asked if this would affect vehicle allowance. Commissioner Miller stated vehicle allowance is based on the mileage reimbursement.

Commissioner Elkin asked if a budget revision would have to be done to cover any additional expenses. Mrs. Pitchford stated she did not believe so if the mileage reimbursement is change but one might have to be done for vehicle allowance.

The Commission will continue to discuss this after the reports are given to them.
