D. First Reading 79-02NOV06 – Georgetown Subdivision Drainage Improvements

Ms. Turner reported the Bid for the Georgetown Subdivision Drainage Improvements closed on November 2, 2006. Seven bids were received. Purchasing and the Public Work's department recommend award to Lehman Construction, LLC for submitting the low bid.

Total cost of contract is \$86,000.00 with a 10% contingency of \$8,600.00 for a total purchase order amount of \$94,600.00. This contract will be paid out of department 2045 – Public Works Design and Construction, account number 71100 – Outside Services. The original budget was \$70,000.00. Public Works anticipates the amount over budget will be covered by funds remaining from the deletion of the Thomas Hill Bridge Project which had a 2006 budgeted amount of \$100,000.00.

3. Budget Amendment – Increase General Revenue Budget

Ms. Kay Murray, Treasurers office was present on behalf of this item.

Ms. Murray stated the need to transfer residual assets from two debt services funds to the General Fund. It is a budget amendment to increase the Gen Rev Budget a total of \$62,058.91. This amount is due to the closing out of two NID Debt Service funds approved in 1994 and 1996. The bonds and the NIDS are paid in full. The overage amount is due to interest and penalties collected through out the life of the bonds (10 years).

There was no discussion about putting this in a separate fund for NIDS overages and to cover preliminary staff time. There was no public comment.

Acting Commissioner Elkin stated this is a first reading and requested the Deputy County Clerk to schedule this item for a second reading at the next available meeting with an appropriate order for award.

4. Commissioner Reports

Commissioner Elkin reported On October 1, 2006, the beginning balance in the C.A.S.H. County Program was \$42,059.03. Donations during the month were \$2,293.80, interest was \$64.12, and disbursements totaled \$7,205.72, leaving a balance of \$37,211.23.

On October 1, 2006, the beginning balance in the H.E.L.P. County Program was \$9,561.50. Donations during the month were \$1,516.26, interest was \$14.58, and disbursements totaled \$4,263.04, leaving a balance of \$6829.30.
