The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m.

1. Planning and Building Inspection

Mr. Stan Shawver, Planning and Zoning was present on behalf of these items

A. Adopt 2006 International Building Codes

Mr. Shawver presented the 2006 International Building Codes for Boone County. He stated the City of Columbia and Boone County will, for the first time, mirror each other in regards to building codes. From the beginning it has been a joint effort and all trades have been vocal on the collaboration.

Commissioner Miller moved now on this day the County Commission of the County of Boone does hereby adopt the Boone County Building Code, including: the International Building Code/2006; the International Residential Code/2006; the International Plumbing Code/2006; the International Mechanical Code/2006; the International Fuel Gas Code/2006; and, the National Electrical Code/2005.

All codes are adopted as amended, including appendixes and referenced standards, as recommended by the Boone County Building Code Commission. All previous versions of the Boone County Building Code are considered to be repealed on the effective date of the code.

Commissioner Elkin seconded the motion

Commissioner Miller wanted to express her gratitude towards the people who were responsible for combining their efforts to make this possible. It was definitely a group effort.

Mr. Page stated this has been a good process. He is pleased with the fact that we are mirroring the city, and hopes that the codes are enforced the same. It will not matter how much time was spent on creating the code, if it is not enforced.

B. Department Annual Report

Mr. Shawver, Director, presented the 2006 Annual Report for the Planning and Building Inspection

Mr. Shawver reported during the past year, the Planning Department processed 12 requests to rezone land. Only eight of the requests were considered by the County Commission, of which 7 were approved.

The requests that received approval totaled 123.2 acres of land. The largest request that was approved involved rezoning land that was zoned A-2 (Agriculture) to A-RP (Planned Agriculture Residential). That request was for 52.79 acres of land that will eventually be subdivided.

The Commission also received **14** requests for conditional use permits, twelve of which were approved.

During 2006, the Planning and Zoning Commission approved 57 final plats comprising 663.63 acres, divided into 254 lots. The Planning Commission also reviewed 5 preliminary plats comprising 280.67 acres with a potential for another 247 lots. In addition, the Planning Department processed 41 administrative surveys.
