Total cost of contract is \$730,828.56 with a 10% contingency of \$73,082.86 for a total Purchase

Order amount of \$803,911.42. This contract will be paid out of department 2040 – Public Works Maintenance Operations, account number 71100 – Outside Services. The original budget was \$740,652.00.
