The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m.

Public Works

David Mink, Director Public Works, was present on behalf of these items.

1. Public Hearing: Speed Limit Studies

a. Hartley Road

Mr. Mink stated Public Works is recommending lowering the speed limit on Hartley Road from State Route HH to Mount Zion Church Road to 30 Miles per Hour (mph). The speed limit for this section of road is currently 35 mph.

This is the second of 3 public hearings. The final public hearing will be held on Tuesday, February 26, 2008, at 9:30 a.m. in the Commission Chambers. The final public hearing will be held on Thursday, March 6, 2008, at 1:30 p.m. in the Commission Chambers.

b. Fairgrounds Road

Mr. Mink stated this speed limit study was done on Fairgrounds Road in Sturgeon, Missouri. This study was done in a school zone. The current speed limit in the school zone is 20 mph from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., and a speed limit of 30 mph at all other times. Following the study, Public Works is recommending the speed limit be changed to 30 mph from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. and from 2:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. The recommended speed limit for all other times is 40 mph.
