2. Photocopier Purchase for Boone County Recorder (first reading)

Ms. Bobbitt stated the Boone County Recorder's Office requests permission to replace the two leased photocopiers in the Recorder's Office with two photocopiers from the University of Missouri cooperative contract G031407. The cooperative contract was approved by commission order 196-2008.

The Canon ImageRunner 5065 copiers are \$17,105.00 each for a Purchase Requisition total of \$34,390.00. Costs will be paid from Department 1160 – Recorder, Account 92000 – Replacement Office Equipment.

Commissioner Pearson stated this is a first reading and requested the Deputy County Clerk to schedule this item for a second reading at the next available commission meeting with an appropriate order for approval.

3. 15-03APR08 – Minor Hill Road Bank Stabilization (first read on 4/3/08)

Ms. Bobbitt stated the bid for the Minor Hill Road Bank Stabilization project closed on April 15, 2008. Three bids were received. Public Works recommends award to C.L. Richardson Construction for offering the lowest and best bid for Boone County.

Total cost of contract is \$171,739.00 with a 10% contingency amount of \$17,173.90 for a Purchase Order total of \$188,912.90. Contract will be paid from Department 2045 – PW – Design and Construction, Account 71100 – Outside Services. The budgeted amount was \$130,000. The Road and Bridge fund ended Fiscal Year 2007 with sufficient funds to cover the difference. However, a budget amendment will not be prepared at this time and only as necessary should savings from other projects be insufficient.

Commissioner Elkin moved on this day the County Commission of the County of Boone does hereby award bid 15-03APR08 – Minor Hill Road Bank Stabilization to C.L. Richardson Construction. It is further ordered the Presiding Commissioner is hereby authorized to sign said contract.

Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion.

4. 66-25SEP07 – Courthouse Expansion Project – BC-10 – Painting (first read on 9/25/07)

Ms. Bobbitt stated the re-bid for the Courthouse Expansion Project for the Boone County Courthouse closed on September 25, 2007. This contract award recommendation is for bid package BC-10 – Painting. Four bids were received for the painting package. The bid responses were evaluated by Dave Pederson of S.M. Wilson. S.M. Wilson is our contracted firm providing construction management services for the Boone County Courthouse Expansion Project.

S.M. Wilson recommends award to Imhoff Construction, Inc. of Jamestown, Missouri for offering the lowest and best bid for Boone County.

Total contract award is \$192,329.00 and will be paid out of Department 4061 – Courthouse Expansion, Account 71201 – Construction Costs (Materials).

Commissioner Elkin moved on this day the County Commission of the County of Boone does hereby award bid 66-25SEP07 – Courthouse Expansion Project – BC-10 – Painting to Imhoff Construction, Inc. of Jamestown, Missouri. It is further ordered the Presiding Commissioner is hereby authorized to sign said contract.

Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion.

5. 77-30AUG07 – Courthouse Expansion Project – BC-09 – Flooring (first read on 8/30/07)

Ms. Bobbitt stated the bid for the Courthouse Expansion Project for the Boone County Courthouse closed on September 6, 2007. This contract award recommendation is for bid package BC-09 – Courthouse Expansion Project – Flooring. Two bids were received for this package. The bid was evaluated by Dave Pederson of S.M. Wilson. S.M. Wilson is our contracted firm providing construction management services for the Boone County Courthouse Expansion Project.

S.M. Wilson recommends award to Richardet Floor Covering Company, Inc. of Perryville, Missouri, for offering the lowest and best bid for Boone County.

Total contract award is \$294,649.00 and will be paid out of Department 4061 – Courthouse Expansion, Account 71201 – Construction Costs (Materials).

Commissioner Elkin moved on this day the County Commission of the County of Boone does hereby award bid 77-30AUG07 – Courthouse Expansion Project – BC-09 – Flooring to Richardet Floor Covering Company, Inc. of Perryville, Missouri. It is further ordered the Presiding Commissioner is hereby authorized to sign said contract.

Total cost of contract is \$29,032.00 with a 10% contingency amount of \$2,903.20 for a Purchase Order total of \$31,935.20. Contract will be paid from Department 2045 – PW – Design and Construction, Account 71100 – Outside Services. The budgeted amount was \$40,000.

Commissioner Elkin moved on this day the County Commission of the County of Boone does hereby award bid 17-03APR08 – Lake of the Woods Culvert Rehabilitation to Don Schneider's Excavating Company. It is further ordered the Presiding Commissioner is hereby authorized to sign said contract.
