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

We have yet to receive word from OSCA on the grant award for FY03. No personnel are involved in this grant.





The Public Works department and I have reviewed the responses received and recommend awarding by category to two vendors, Tiemann Industrial Supply and H P Products.

The breakdown is as follows:

Category A - Multi-Gas Monitor - Tiemann Industrial Supply

Category B – Air Purifying Respirator – Tiemann Industrial Supply

Category C - Self Contained Breathing Apparatus - H P Products

Category D - Welding Respirator - H P Products

Category E - Confined Space Blower - Tiemann Industrial Supply

Category F – Fall Protection Equipment – H P Products

Category G – Spill Kit Supplies – Tiemann Industrial Supply

- 1. *Contract Documents* This agreement shall consist of this Purchase Agreement for Confined Space Equipment and Accessories, County of Boone Request for Bid for Confined Space Equipment and Accessories, bid number 42-18JUN02 including Instructions and General Conditions of Bidding, Primary Specifications, Response Presentation and Review, the unexecuted Response Form and Addendum One, as well as the Contractor's bid response dated June 17, 2002 executed by David E. Wilson on behalf of the Contractor. All such documents shall constitute the contract documents which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Service or product data, specification and literature submitted with bid response may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office bid file for this bid if not attached. In the event of conflict between any of the foregoing documents, the terms, conditions, provisions and requirements contained in the bid specifications including Instructions and General Conditions of Bidding, Primary Specifications, Response Presentation and Review and the unexecuted Response Form and Addendum One shall prevail and control over the Contractor's bid response.
- 2. *Purchase* The County agrees to purchase from the Contractor and the Contractor agrees to supply the County with the following: Category A Multi Gas Monitor for \$1625.00; Category B Air Purifying Respirator 2 each for \$201.80; Category E Confined Space Blower/Exhaust Fan for \$785.00; Category G Optional Equipment excluding sections 4.7.7.6. and 4.7.7.7. for a total of \$843.00. Total Contract value is \$3,454.80.
- 3. *Delivery* Contractor agrees to deliver the benches stated above to the Public Works Department with in two (2) weeks after order.
- 4. *Billing and Payment* All billing shall be invoiced to the Boone County Public Works Department. Billings may only include the prices listed in the Contractor's bid response. No additional fees for delivery or extra services or taxes shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in the Contractor's bid response to the specifications. The County agrees to pay all invoices within thirty days of receipt; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts offered in its bid response if county makes payment as provided therein.
