Marlene, Melinda, and Ted:

I received the contract for the purchase of a cargo van which is to be paid from the proceeds of the new 1/8-cent law enforcement sales tax. It was routed to me for Auditor Certification. I understand that this contract is scheduled for a first reading by the Commission tomorrow (Thursday).

Contracts are not valid or enforceable against the County unless they are certified by the Auditor. **Here's the problem:** According to RSMo 50.660, I cannot legally certify this contract until two things occur.

- 1) A budget is established and there is an unencumbered balance to credit of the appropriation to which the purchase is to be charged, and
- 2) There is an available cash balance in the fund from which the contract obligation will be paid

Both of these criteria should be satisfied as of January 1, 2003., but not before. I'll explain:

The appropriations in the new Law Enforcement Services Fund (department numbers 2901, 2902, 2903, 2904, 2905) will be established when the commission adopts the FY 03 budget. That budget will be effective January 1, 2003, the same date that the new 1/8-cent sales tax becomes effective. Therefore, criteria #1 should be met as of January 1, 2003. (I should point out that the Commission has until January 31st to adopt the budget for 2003. While I fully expect the Commission to adopt the budget on or before January 1st, I cannot guarantee that this will happen.)

Criteria #2 requires an available cash balance. The 1/8-cent sales tax goes into effect January 1, 2003; however, we won't begin receiving cash until sometime in February or March. In order to make cash available in the fund on January 1st (the effective date for both the tax and the budget), the county commission has agreed that the General Fund will loan cash to the Law Enforcement Services Fund beginning January 1, 2003. Therefore, criteria #2 will be met as of January 1, 2003.

Based on the foregoing, I am sure you agree that I cannot legally certify the pending contract at this time.

Please advise me as to how you want to proceed. In the meantime, I am holding the contract. Thanks,
