ADDENDUM TO LEGAL SERVICES COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, Boone County Group Homes and Family Support, now known as Boone County Family Resources (BCFR), and Boone County, Missouri have entered into a Legal Services Cooperative Agreement dated March 12, 2002; and

WHEREAS, Boone County and BCFR desire to continue under a Legal Services Cooperative Agreement; and

WHEREAS, for the ease of budgeting and record administration of both parties, the parties desire to enter into an Addendum to said agreement addressing a modification of the payment provisions.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED TO BY AND BETWEEN PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. BCFR will remit to Boone County the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) per month as and for general legal services provided under the Cooperative Agreement.
- 2.
