Responsibilities: Maintain law and order and serve legal process of the courts by performing duties, including but not limited to; processing citizen complaints, documenting and writing reports on law violations, transporting prisoners, service of civil process, and overall general law enforcement in the County.

Working Hours: Evenings, Nights, Weekends

Qualifications: High School Diploma or equivalent; must be 21 years of age or older at time of hire; applicant must not have any felony convictions; must not have other criminal convictions within the last 2 years, excluding traffic violations; visual acuity of at least 20/200 correctable to 20/20 in both eyes; must possess a valid Operator's license at time of application and a valid Missouri Operator's license at time of appointment; must possess a valid Class A or B Missouri Peace Officer License or current enrollment in a police academy. Applicants must be able to meet the strenuous physical demands of law enforcement activities which include, at a minimum, the ability to engage in foot pursuits, to make forcible arrests, and to operate law enforcement equipment, including firearms. No marijuana use or possession in the past 2 years, and no other illegal drug use or possession in the past 5 years. **Must pass a pre-employment drug screen.** Must pass the online keyboarding score with a minimum score of 35 NET wpm, or forward a copy of a valid keyboarding score taken in the last year from your local Workforce Development (Career) Center. Must reside in Boone County. Must meet minimum qualifications set forth by the FBI and MSHP CJIS Security policy.

Starting Hourly Pay: \$20.77/hour. Additional \$.65 per hour shift differential.

Additional Forms Required: Authorization, Military Release (Sheriff Department), Request for Tax Transcript (Sheriff Department), typing test
