## PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR MOTOR GRADER, MOWER, AND SNOW PLOW BLADES

THIS AGREEMENT dated the \_\_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_\_ 2006 is made between Boone County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State d Missouri through the Boone County Commission, herein "County" and Lacal Equipment, Inc., herein "Contractor."

IN CONSIDERATION of the parties performance of the respective obligations contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Contract Documents This agreement shall consist of this Purchase Agreement for the Motor Grader, Mower and Snow Plow Blades, bid number 28-18APR06 including Introduction and General Conditions of Bidding, Primary Specifications, Response Presentation and Review, the unexecuted Response Form, Standard Terms & Conditions, any applicable addenda, as well as the Contractor's bid response dated April 7, 2006 and executed by Roger Detrick, on behalf of the Contractor. All such documents shall constitute the contract documents which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Service or product data, specification and literature submitted with bid response may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office bid file for this bid if not attached. In the event of conflict between any of the foregoing documents, the terms, conditions, provisions and requirements contained in the bid specifications including Introduction and General Conditions of Bidding, Primary Specifications, Response Presentation and Review, the unexecuted Response Form, Standard Terms & Conditions, and any applicable addenda shall prevail and control over the Contractor's bid response.
- 2. **Purchase** The County agrees to purchase from the Contractor and the Contractor agrees to supply the County with the following:

- 3. **Delivery** Contractor agrees to deliver the equipment per the bid specifications and within 5 to 7 Days after receipt of order.
- 4. **Billing and Payment** All billing shall be invoiced to Boone County Public Work's Department and billings may only include the prices listed in the Contractor's bid response. No additional fees for delivery or extra services or taxes shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in the Contractor's bid response to the specifications. The County agrees to pay all invoices within thirty days of receipt; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts offered in its bid response if county makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount; in the event the billing dispute is resolved in favor of the Contractor, the County agrees to pay interest at a rate of 9% per annum on disputed amounts withheld commencing from the last date that payment was due.
- 5. **Binding Effect** This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this agreement remains in full force and effect.

- 6. **Entire Agreement** This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and any other bid or bid specification or contractual agreement. This agreement may only be amended by a signed writing executed with the same formality as this agreement.

#### 1.2. **DEFINITIONS**

- 1.2.1. County This term refers to the County of Boone, a duly organized public entity. - 1.2.2. Bidder / Contractor / Supplier These terms refer generally to businesses having some sort of relationship to or with us. The term may apply differently to different classes of entities, as the context will indicate. Bidder - Any business entity submitting a response to this Bid. Suppliers, which may be invited to respond, or which express interest in this bid, but which do not submit a response, have no obligations with respect to the bid requirements.
  - Contractor The Bidder whose response to this bid is found by Purchasing to meet the best interests of the County. The Contractor will be selected for award, and will enter into a Contract for provision of the goods and/or services described in the Bid.
  - Supplier All business/s entities which may provide the subject goods and/or services.
- 1.2.3. Bid This entire document, including attachments. A Bid may be used to solicit various kinds of information. The kind of information this Bid seeks is indicated by the title appearing at the top of the first page. An "Invitation For Bid" is used when the need is well defined. An "Invitation For Proposal" is used when the County will consider solutions, which may vary significantly from each other or from the County's initial expectations.

All curved motor grader blades must have square counter-sunk 5/8" holes spaced 6" OC from edges with additional holes spaced 3" OC from either edge.
  - 2.2.2. Brush Cutter Blades
- 2.2.2.1. Brush cutter blades, nuts and bolts must meet equipment manufacturer specifications that are being bid. Cutter blades to fit a 50" side mount Tiger mower model #TRB50 with a three blade stump jumper. Cutter blades to fit a 50" side mount Tiger Saber mower with a two blade stump jumper.
  - 2.2.3. Snow Plow Blades
- 2.2.3.1. Large snow plow blades to be 5/8" x 8" x 10' and 5/8" x 8" x 11' carbon steel blades. 5/8" blade mounting holes to be spaced 3" from each end and 12" OC on center holes (standard highway punch), and are flush (no counter-sinking required).
- 2.2.3.2. Optional Hardened 10' Snow Plow Blades Large snow plow blades to be 5/8" x 8" x 10' and 5/8" x 8" x 11' carbon steel blades. 5/8" blade mounting holes to be spaced 3" from each end and 12" OC on center holes (standard highway punch), and are flush (no counter-sinking required). Wear edge must be hardened to Rockwell C62 ± 5 specification.
- 2.2.3.3. Smaller Snow Plow Blades 8.5' blade (1/2" thickness) to fit a Western Pro plow and 9' blade (1/2" thickness) to fit a Western Pro Plus plow. All blades shall meet plow manufacturer's standards for construction.
  - 2.3. **DEVIATION(S) -** It is the bidder's responsibility to submit a bid that meets all mandatory specifications stated within. The bidder must compare their product bid with the required listed minimum specifications and identify any deviations along with the specific section deviated from. Failure to properly identify deviations may render the bidder's proposal non-responsive and not capable of consideration for award. #### **AGREEMENT**

This agreement is entered into this <u>Ist</u> day of <u>May</u>, 2006 between the City of Columbia, Missouri, a municipal corporation ("City") and the County of Boone, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri ("County").

WHEREAS, City annexations frequently create islands of either City or County maintenance jurisdiction (isolated roadways) or areas where the maintenance jurisdiction is divided by a road centerline (shared roadways); and

WHEREAS, these shared or isolated roadways create areas of shared maintenance responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, City and the County desire to provide routine maintenance services for shared or isolated roads in an efficient manner; and

WHEREAS, City and the County desire to jointly plan major maintenance projects for shared or isolated roads; and

WHEREAS, City and County are in agreement that a plan should be developed and reviewed at least annually by their respective public works departments to provide and coordinate these services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. ANNUAL MEETING: Representatives from City and County public works departments shall meet each May to develop a work plan and budget for snow removal, maintenance and capital improvements for roads of shared maintenance responsibility. Representatives from each department must include a person in a position of administrative authority with input in the budgetary process. At least two weeks before any meeting, a map of roads with shared maintenance responsibilities shall be provided by the City public works department to the County public works department for review. The departments shall develop a work plan after they agree on the roads to be covered by the plan.

#### 2. WORK PLANS:

a. Snow Removal: The snow removal plan must clearly define responsibilities for snow removal operations. The snow removal plan shall be based on operational reasonableness and efficiency considerations rather than strict mileage tabulations, but the departments shall attempt to divide the work as evenly as possible. City and County public works departments shall provide snow removal service as part of their regular routine just as they would for any road of equal classification and shall agree upon the priority level assigned to each road. The snow removal plan shall be signed by City and County public works directors and copies of the document shall be kept on file in each department's administrative

- offices. City and County public works directors shall inform or seek consent of their respective governing bodies according to agency requirements.
- b. Pavement and Stormwater Capital and Major Maintenance Projects: Proposed capital and major maintenance projects shall be identified with a goal to develop a coordinated plan for funding and construction. The plan shall outline responsibilities for funding, design, and construction of the proposed projects. All projects are subject to approval and funding authorization by the respective governing bodies according to agency requirements.

- c. Minor Maintenance and Regulatory Control: If a cooperative effort is deemed to be practical or cost effective and in the best interest of the public, City and County public works departments shall agree upon a strategy and allocate cost according to jurisdiction, subject to the approval process for the respective agency. If a road is not included in a cooperative agreement, minor maintenance, such as pothole repair, shall continue to be the responsibility of the agency of jurisdiction. Gravel road maintenance and snow removal may require a fair trade agreement since routine gravel road maintenance is best done by a single provider. Sign maintenance, including regulatory control and permitting procedures, such as driveway access or utility permits, shall remain with the agency of jurisdiction.
- d. Adjustments to Work Plan: Because roadways are continuously annexed throughout the year, provisions shall be made in the plan that clearly outline how snow removal activities and maintenance responsibilities shall be adjusted to ensure no interruption or omission of services on these roadways. It is recommended that any adjustments be documented in writing on a pre-approved form and verified by signature of the City or County public works director (or their duly appointed representative) to be an agreed amendment to the plan. The City or County public works director shall inform or seek consent of their respective governing bodies according to agency requirements.
- e. Budgeting: Every effort shall be made by City and County public works departments to coordinate capital and major maintenance projects at least one year in advance of the start of construction. Because each agency operates within a different fiscal calendar year, the annual meeting shall occur during the month of May to allow each agency to take the appropriate budgetary action to ensure implementation of the plan. Snow removal responsibilities and gravel road maintenance shall be divided based on practical considerations for efficient operations as equally as possible so that the budgetary impact to both agencies is neutral for all practical purposes.
- f. Communication: City will inform County of any annexation that creates a shared or isolated roadway within one week of the annexation. To ensure the provisions of this policy are met, a notice of the annexation shall be specifically addressed to the County public works director. A joint effort shall by made by the City and

County to inform the public of changes in road maintenance responsibilities so the public will be aware of the appropriate agency to contact.
