



FINDING OF PUBLIC NUISANCE AND ORDER FOR ABATEMENT

NOW on this 21st day of June 2011, the County Commission of Boone County, Missouri met in regular session and entered the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order for abatement of nuisance:

Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law

The County Commission finds as fact and concludes as a matter of law the following:

1. The Boone County Code of Health Regulations (the "Code") are officially noticed and are made a part of the record in this proceeding.
2. The City of Columbia/Boone County Health Department administrative record is made a part of the record in this proceeding and incorporated herein by reference. In addition, any live testimony of the official(s) of the department and other interested persons are made a part of the record in this proceeding.
3. A public nuisance exists described as follows: growth of weeds in excess of twelve inches high
4. The location of the public nuisance is as follows: 2505 E. Oakbrook Drive A+B, a/k/a parcel# 12-415-20-02-005.00 01, Section 20, Township 49, Range 12 as shown in deed book 2988 page 0026, Boone County and 2510 E. Oakbrook Drive A+B, Columbia, MO, and parcel # 12-415-20-02-018.00 01, Section 20, Township 49, Range 12 as shown in deed book 2988 page 0026, Boone County
5. The specific violation of the Code is: growth of weeds in excess of twelve inches high in violation of section 6.7 of the Code
6. The Health Director's designated Health Official made the above determination of the existence of the public nuisance at the above location. Notice of that determination and the requirement for abatement was given in accordance with section 6.10.1 of the Code on the 21st day of May 2011, to the property owner, occupant, and any other applicable interested persons.
7. The above described public nuisance was not abated. As required by section 6.10.2 of the Code, the property owner, occupant, and any other applicable interested persons were given notice of the hearing conducted this date before the Boone County Commission for an order to abate the above nuisance at government expense with the cost and expense thereof to be charged against the above described property as a special tax bill and added to the real estate taxes for said property for the current year.

8. No credible evidence has been presented at the hearing to demonstrate that no public nuisance exists or that abatement has been performed or is unnecessary; accordingly, in accordance with section 6.10.2 of the Code and section 67.402, RSMo, the County Commission finds and determines from the credible evidence presented that a public nuisance exists at the above location which requires abatement and that the parties responsible for abating such nuisance have failed to do so as required by the Health Director or Official's original order referred to above.


Order For Abatement Chargeable As a Special Assessment To The Property

It is further ordered and directed that the Health Director submit a bill for the cost and expense of abatement to the County Clerk for attachment to this order and that the County Clerk submit a certified copy of this order and such bill to the County Collector for inclusion as a special assessment on the real property tax bill for the above described property for the current year in accordance with section 67.402, RSMo.



**PURCHASE AGREEMENT
FOR

Secondary Supplier

THIS AGREEMENT dated the _____ day of _____ 2011 is made between Boone County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri through the Boone County Commission, herein "County" and **Central Concrete Co**, herein "Contractor."

IN CONSIDERATION of the parties performance of the respective obligations contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Contract Documents - This agreement shall consist of this Purchase Agreement for **Ready Mix Concrete/Cement Term and Supply**, County of Boone Request for Bid for Ready Mix Concrete/Cement Term and Supply, bid number **13-15APR11**, any applicable addenda, and the Contractor's bid response dated **April 05, 2011** and executed by **Cooper Snyder** on behalf of the Contractor. All such documents shall constitute the contract documents, which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Service or product data, specification and literature submitted with bid response may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office bid file for this bid if not attached. In the event of conflict between any of the foregoing documents, this Purchase Agreement, the Request for Bid and any applicable addenda shall prevail and control over the Contractor's bid response.

2. Contract Duration - This agreement shall be for the period **beginning on the date of award through April 30, 2012** subject to the provisions for termination specified below. This agreement may be extended beyond the expiration date by order of the County for **two (2) additional one-year periods** subject to the pricing clauses in the Contractor's bid response. This agreement may be extended beyond the expiration date by order of the County on a month to month basis in the event the County is unable to re-bid and/or award a new contract prior to the expiration date.

3. Purchase - The County agrees to purchase from the Contractor and the Contractor agrees to supply the County the items as required in the bid specifications and in conformity with the contract documents for the prices set forth in the Contractor's bid response. **Central Concrete Co.** shall act as the Secondary supplier and shall furnish all items bid, as needed and as ordered by the County.

4. Delivery - Contractor agrees to deliver the items as specified within one day after receipt of order.

5. Billing and Payment - All billing shall be invoiced to the **Boone County Public Works Department** and billings may only include the prices listed in the Contractor's bid response. No additional fees for delivery or extra services not included in the bid response or taxes shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in the Contractor's bid response to the specifications. The County agrees to pay all invoices within thirty days of receipt; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts offered in its bid response if county makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount; in the event the billing dispute is resolved in favor of the Contractor, the County agrees to pay interest at a rate of 9% per annum on disputed amounts withheld commencing from the last date that payment was due.

6. Binding Effect - This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this agreement remains in full force and effect.

7. **Entire Agreement** - This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and any other bid or bid specification or contractual agreement. This agreement may only be amended by a signed writing executed with the same formality as this agreement.

8. **Termination** - This agreement may be terminated by the County upon thirty days advance written notice for any of the following reasons or under any of the following circumstances:


- a. County may terminate this agreement due to material breach of any term or condition of this agreement, or
- b. County may terminate this agreement if in the opinion of the Boone County Commission if delivery of products are delayed or products delivered are not in conformity with bidding specifications or variances authorized by County, or
- c. If appropriations are not made available and budgeted for any calendar year.





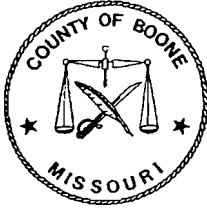

ARTICLE I

PURPOSE AND AUTHORITY

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets forth the points of agreement between the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and Central Concrete Company (Employer) regarding the Employer's participation in the Employment Eligibility Verification Program (E-Verify).
