THIS AGREEMENT dated the 12th day of December 2013 is made between Boone County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri through the Boone County Commission, herein "County" and **Metal Culverts, Inc.**, herein "Contractor."

IN CONSIDERATION of the parties performance of the respective obligations contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Contract Documents - This agreement shall consist of this Purchase Agreement for **Metal Culvert Pipe Term & Supply**, County of Boone Request for Bid for Metal Culvert Pipe Term & Supply, bid number **45-13NOV13**, Introduction and General Conditions of Bidding, Primary Specifications, Response Presentation and Review, any applicable addenda, the unexecuted Response Form, Standard Terms and Conditions, as well as the Contractor's bid response **dated October 31, 2013** and executed by **Greg Brauner** on behalf of the Contractor. All such documents shall constitute the contract documents which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Service or product data, specification and literature submitted with bid response may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office bid file for this bid if not attached. In the event of conflict between any of the foregoing documents, this Purchase Agreement, the Introduction and General Conditions of Bidding, Primary Specifications, Response Presentation and Review, the unexecuted Response Form, Standard Terms and Conditions, and applicable Addenda shall prevail and control over the Contractor's bid response.

2. Contract Duration - This agreement shall **commence on January 1, 2014 and extend through June 30, 2014** subject to the provisions for termination specified below. This agreement may be extended beyond the expiration date by order of the County for six (6) additional six month periods subject to the pricing clauses in the Contractor's bid response and thereafter on a month to month basis for a maximum of six (6) months in the event the County is unable to re-bid and/or award a new contract prior to the expiration date after exercising diligent efforts to do so or not. Pricing may be adjusted at renewal time for no more than **10% increase** at any renewal period, however, **Metal Culverts** may no longer be the Primary Contractor in a subsequent renewal period if their prices surpass the Secondary Contractors prices.

3. Basic Services - The County agrees to purchase on an as-needed basis from the Contractor and the Contractor agrees to supply the County with Metal Culvert Pipe as the **Primary Supplier**. Items will be provided as required in the bid specifications and in conformity with the contract documents for the prices set forth in the Contractor's bid response, as needed and as ordered by County.

4. Delivery - Contractor agrees to provide the items and service as specified and as agreed to in the bid specifications and within 21 days after receipt of order.

5. Billing and Payment - All billing shall be invoiced to Boone County Public Works and billings may only include the prices listed in the Contractor's bid response. No additional fees for delivery or extra services not included in the bid response or taxes shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in the Contractor's bid response to the specifications. The County agrees to pay all invoices within thirty days of receipt; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts offered in its bid response if county makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount; in the event

the billing dispute is resolved in favor of the Contractor, the County agrees to pay interest at a rate of 9% per annum on disputed amounts withheld commencing from the last date that payment was due.

6. **Binding Effect** - This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this agreement remains in full force and effect.

7. **Entire Agreement** - This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and any other bid or bid specification or contractual agreement. This agreement may only be amended by a signed writing executed with the same formality as this agreement.

8. **Termination** - This agreement may be terminated by the County upon thirty days advance written notice for any of the following reasons or under any of the following circumstances:

- a. County may terminate this agreement due to material breach of any term or condition of this agreement, or
- b. County may terminate this agreement if in the opinion of the Boone County Commission if delivery of products are delayed or products delivered are not in conformity with bidding specifications or variances authorized by County, or
- c. If appropriations are not made available and budgeted for any calendar year.

THIS AGREEMENT dated the 12th day of December 2013 is made between Boone County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri through the Boone County Commission, herein "County" and **Contech Engineered Solutions LLC**, herein "Contractor."

IN CONSIDERATION of the parties performance of the respective obligations contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. **Contract Documents** - This agreement shall consist of this Purchase Agreement for **Metal Culvert Pipe Term & Supply**, County of Boone Request for Bid for Metal Culvert Pipe Term & Supply, bid number **45-13NOV13**, Introduction and General Conditions of Bidding, Primary Specifications, Response Presentation and Review, any applicable addenda, the unexecuted Response Form, Standard Terms and Conditions, as well as the Contractor's bid response dated **November 11, 2013** and executed by **Josh Dickenson** on behalf of the Contractor. All such documents shall constitute the contract documents which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Service or product data, specification and literature submitted with bid response may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office bid file for this bid if not attached. In the event of conflict between any of the foregoing documents, this Purchase Agreement, the Introduction and General Conditions of Bidding, Primary Specifications, Response Presentation and Review, the unexecuted Response Form, Standard Terms and Conditions, and applicable Addenda shall prevail and control over the Contractor's bid response.

2. **Contract Duration** - This agreement shall **commence on January 1, 2014 and extend through June 30, 2014** subject to the provisions for termination specified below. This agreement may be extended beyond the expiration date by order of the County for six (6) additional six month periods subject to the pricing clauses in the Contractor's bid response and thereafter on a month to month basis for a maximum of six (6) months in the event the County is unable to re-bid and/or award a new contract prior to the expiration date after exercising diligent efforts to do so or not.

3. **Basic Services** - The County agrees to purchase on an as-needed basis from the Contractor and the Contractor agrees to supply the County with Metal Culvert Pipe as the **Secondary Supplier**. Items will be provided as required in the bid specifications and in conformity with the contract documents for the prices set forth in the Contractor's bid response, as needed and as ordered by County.

4. **Delivery** - Contractor agrees to provide the items and service as specified and as agreed to in the bid specifications and within 14 days after receipt of order.

5. **Billing and Payment** - All billing shall be invoiced to Boone County Public Works and billings may only include the prices listed in the Contractor's bid response. No additional fees for delivery or extra services not included in the bid response or taxes shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in the Contractor's bid response to the specifications. The County agrees to pay all invoices within thirty days of receipt; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts offered in its bid response if county makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount; in the event the billing dispute is resolved in favor of the Contractor, the County agrees to pay interest at a rate of 9% per annum on disputed amounts withheld commencing from the last date that payment was due.

- 2.6. **Award** – A single vendor will be awarded the bid. Therefore, vendors are required to bid on all items.

The purpose of this request is to seek approval to purchase consulting services from MRC Software (Michaels, Ross and Cole, LTD). MRC Software is the company which created, maintains and supports the mPower Software Development platform. Boone County IT has identified a need to be able to quickly deploy applications created in mPower to many users from multiple different agencies, organizations and roles in general.

Examples would include county users who have IDs on the AS400 and those that do not. Currently we can only authenticate security from one system for a given application. If the user does not have an ID on that system, they must be added and then IT manage a new user ID. With the enhancement in place we will be able to validate with a county employee's network user name and password to secure the application versus adding them to the AS400, which they may not use for any other purpose.

Another example would be external users where the county would like them to use internal applications. An example of this would be cross agency tasks or information sharing. If the Sheriff Department has a mPower application all of their staff have access to we currently validate their security via the AS400. If they have a cross agency task and need someone from CPD or Joint Communications to have access to use that same application, we would need to make them users on our system. With the enhancement in place we could continue to validate all the current internal users from the AS400 and external users could be added to a secondary database for security validation and remove them when the process is complete. IT would not be required to manage external users on an internal production system just for user security.

There are many more examples; however the last one I will share for the purpose of this justification would be secured publicly facing applications that internal users need to use. If we have a secured application on our web site that we require a user name and password, currently county employees must sign up for another user name and password. With the requested enhancement, we would be able to allow a county employee to use their AS400 user name and password or their network user name and password to access that same publicly facing application. If they leave employment with the County, they then would be required to sign up as everyone else.

Actual expenditures in Information Technology class 9 (1170) software purchases in FY2013 has been less than budgeted and we anticipate that the cost of this item can be covered from these savings.







The purpose of this request is to seek approval to purchase consulting services from MRC Software (Michaels, Ross and Cole, LTD). MRC Software is the company which created, maintains and supports the mPower Software Development platform. Boone County IT has identified a need to be able to quickly deploy applications created in mPower to many users from multiple different agencies, organizations and roles in general.

Examples would include county users who have IDs on the AS400 and those that do not. Currently we can only authenticate security from one system for a given application. If the user does not have an ID on that system, they must be added and then IT manage a new user ID. With the enhancement in place we will be able to validate with a county employee's network user name and password to secure the application versus adding them to the AS400, which they may not use for any other purpose.

Another example would be external users where the county would like them to use internal applications. An example of this would be cross agency tasks or information sharing. If the Sheriff Department has a mPower application all of their staff have access to we currently validate their security via the AS400. If they have a cross agency task and need someone from CPD or Joint Communications to have access to use that same application, we would need to make them users on our system. With the enhancement in place we could continue to validate all the current internal users from the AS400 and external users could be added to a secondary database for security validation and remove them when the process is complete. IT would not be required to manage external users on an internal production system just for user security.

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Actual expenditures in Information Technology class 9 (1170) software purchases in FY2013 has been less than budgeted and we anticipate that the cost of this item can be covered from these savings.
