Whereas, motorcycle riding is a popular form of recreation and transportation for millions of people across the state and nation; and

Whereas, Missouri has 73,160 registered motorcycles and 250 motor-tricycles and 268,900 individuals who have valid operator and chauffeurs licenses with a motorcycle endorsement; and

Whereas, the safe operation of a motorcycle requires the use of special skills developed through a combination of training and experience, the use of good judgement, and a thorough knowledge of traffic laws and licensing regulations; and

Whereas, all motorcycle organizations, clubs, dealerships, groups, and highway safety officials in our state should join with Freedom of Road Riders, Inc. and concerned citizens in actively promoting motorcycle safety and awareness during the month of May, 2001; and

Whereas, the Motorcycle Awareness and You campaign is intended to prevent accidents, injuries, and fatalities associated with motorcycling by encouraging motorcycle operators to participate in rider education programs, wear the proper apparel, and operate their vehicle defensively according to the rules of the road; and
