The Public Works department and Purchasing have reviewed the responses from the above referenced bid. We recommend rejecting bids received from Missouri Communications, Central Communications, Ohio Valley 2-way Radio and Advanced Wireless. They all left off one important specification to the radios, the DTMF encode/decode which codes the incoming signal and decode back to the repeater which makes our calls our more secure. After contacting each vendor, they acknowledge omitting this element.

We further recommend award to the next lowest bidder, Mo Comm Electronics, for seven mobile 2-way radios, amplifiers, antennas and speakers as specified for a contract price of \$8,179.50. This was budgeted in organization 2040 account 92300 for \$32,900.00. There is one remaining piece of equipment, a repeater, to be paid from this line item at a later date

# PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR MOBILE 2-WAY RADIOS

THIS AGREEMENT dated the	24	day of APRIL	2003 is made between
Boone County, Missouri, a political subd	ivision o	f the State of Missouri	through the Boone County
Commission, herein "County" and Mo C	omm Ele	ctronics, herein "Cont	ractor."

**IN CONSIDERATION** of the parties performance of the respective obligations contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. *Contract Documents* This agreement shall consist of this Purchase Agreement for Mobile 2-way Radios, County of Boone Request for Bid for Mobile 2-way Radios, bid number 19-11MAR03 including Instructions and General Conditions of Bidding, Primary Specifications, Response Presentation and Review, the unexecuted Response Form, as well as the Contractor's bid response dated March 10, 2003 executed by Roy Watkins on behalf of the Contractor. All such documents shall constitute the contract documents which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Service or product data, specification and literature submitted with bid response may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office bid file for this bid if not attached. In the event of conflict between any of the foregoing documents, the terms, conditions, provisions and requirements contained in the bid specifications including Instructions and General Conditions of Bidding, Primary Specifications, Response Presentation and Review and the unexecuted Response Form shall prevail and control over the Contractor's bid response.
- 2. *Purchase* The County agrees to purchase from the Contractor and the Contractor agrees to supply the County with seven (7) Motorola CDM-1250 radios, seven (7) PA3-1FE Amplifiers, seven (7) HAD 4008 VHF Antennas and seven (7) external speakers as specified and responded to in the bid specifications for a contract price of \$8,179.50.
- 3. **Delivery** Contractor agrees to deliver the radios and equipment as stated above to the Public Works Department within ten (10) days after order.
- 4. Billing and Payment All billing shall be invoiced to the Public Works Department. Billings may only include the prices listed in the Contractor's bid response. No additional fees for delivery or extra services or taxes shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in the Contractor's bid response to the specifications. The County agrees to pay all invoices within thirty days of receipt; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts offered in its bid response if county makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount; in the event the billing dispute is resolved in favor of the Contractor, the County agrees to pay interest at a rate of 9% per annum on disputed amounts withheld commencing from the last date that payment was due.
- 5. **Binding Effect** This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this agreement remains in full force and effect.

- 6. *Entire Agreement* This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and any other bid or bid specification or contractual agreement. This agreement may only be amended by a signed writing executed with the same formality as this agreement.
- 7. **Termination** This agreement may be terminated by the County upon thirty days advance written notice for any of the following reasons or under any of the following circumstances:

After reviewing the responses for the above referenced bid, the Commission office and Purchasing department make the following recommendation. We recommend award to Da-Comm of Mid-Missouri for having the lowest and best bid for Copier #2 specified in the bid specifications. Da-Comm bid a Kyrocera KM-4030 with the following alternates: Large Capacity tray, Puncher Unit, Saddle Stitch Finisher and Networking Connections for a purchase amount of \$8,829.00 and a total life cycle cost of \$14,315.00. The amount budgeted for this purchase was \$9,000.00.

In the evaluation, we looked at the total life cycle cost of this purchase. We took into account the total purchase price of the machine including the potential seven year maintenance agreement.

We are also requesting approval to dispose of a Canon NP6030 fixed asset tag #9309. The disposal form is attached.

Per the bid specifications, both vendors have agreed to hold prices through March 31, 2004 if additional purchases are identified before then. For your reference, the bid tabulations for both copiers are attached.

# PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR PHOTOCOPIER AND MAINTENANCE

THIS AGREEMENT dated the 24 day of APRIL 2003 is made between Boone County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri through the Boone County Commission, herein "County" and Da-Comm of Mid-Missouri, herein "Contractor."

**IN CONSIDERATION** of the parties performance of the respective obligations contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Contract Documents This agreement shall consist of this Purchase Agreement for Digital Copiers, bid number 10-11MAR03 including Introduction and General Conditions of Bidding, Primary Specifications and Special Conditions, Response Presentation and Review, the unexecuted Response Form, and Addendum #1, as well as the Contractor's bid response dated March 7, 2003, executed by Brian Barber, on behalf of the Contractor. All such documents shall constitute the contract documents, which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Service or product data, specification and literature submitted with bid response may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office bid file for this bid if not attached. In the event of conflict between any of the foregoing documents, the terms, conditions, provisions and requirements contained in the bid specifications including Introduction and General Conditions of Bidding, Primary Specifications and Special Conditions, Response Presentation and Review, and the unexecuted Response Form shall prevail and control over the Contractor's bid response.
- 2. **Purchase** The County agrees to purchase from the Contractor agrees to supply the following equipment and maintenance:

Commission Office—801 E. Walnut, Room 245, Columbia, MO, one (1) Kyrocera KM-4030 copier (\$5,514.15) with the following Add Alternates: Paper Deck; Saddle Stitch Finisher (\$1,453.50); Puncher Unit (\$387.60) and Network and Scanning capabilities (\$1,473.75) for an equipment and contract cost of \$8,829.00.

Maintenance shall be provided for the copier for 100,000 copies per year. The first ninety days is included in the warranty and then prorated to be billed on a semi-annual basis beginning July 15. Yearly annual maintenance to be \$750 for the first year and will adjust yearly according to the bidders response. Maintenance shall be billed semi-annually with the calendar year and any overage shall be billed in July at a cost of \$.0075 per copy. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount; in the event the billing dispute is resolved in favor of the Contractor, the County agrees to pay interest at a rate of 9% per annum on disputed amounts withheld commencing from the last date that payment was due.

# **CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL**

- 1. Club to provide at least two weeks written notice of an event to any interested party requesting notice.
- 2. Earthen berms to be constructed on all sides of the range.
- 3. Berms to be at least 9 feet high at a 3:1 slope.
- 4. Berm at impact area to be at least 40 feet high.
- 5. Evergreen trees (minimum 3' tall) to be planted at 15' intervals along top of all berms. Any tree that dies to be replaced during next growing season.
- 6. Operating hours from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Operating hours to be posted at the firing line.
- 7. Night firing classes to occur no more than twice per calendar year.
- 8. Shooting not permitted on any federal holiday.
- 9. No more than two competition events per month.
- 10. No fully automatic weapons.
- 11. No more than 20 operating firing lanes (one "dummy" lane allowed on each side of range).
- 12. Class size for training limited to 60 participants.
- 13. Warning signs to be posted along north and west edge of firing range and at the gate.
- 14. No parking allowed on public right-of-way.
- 15. Minimum 40 parking spaces and drive to have minimum chip and seal surface.
- 16. Applicant to provide a 33' half right-of-way along Caldwell Road the length of the property to accommodate future road improvement made necessary by use of subject property.
- 17. Applicant to provide a "double coat" chip seal surface to the remaining unpaved portion of Academy Road and Caldwell Road to 20 feet past the gate to accommodate increase in traffic until such time as a second entrance is developed, then it will be required "double coat" chip seal for the added distance to 20 feet past the new gate for same reason.
- 18. Maintain record of club use of adjoining ranges outside of 600 yard range operating hours.
- 19. Permit expires December 31, 2004 unless the applicant returns and applies for Planned Recreational zoning, if available, under conditions no more stringent than the existing permit.

# FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Subject to the conditions of approval, the Boone County Commission finds and concludes in issuance of this permit that:

- 1. The establishment, maintenance, operation and use of the conditional use permit issued hereunder will not be detrimental to or endanger the public health, safety, comfort or general welfare, and
- 2. The conditional use permit issued hereunder will not be injurious to the use and enjoyment of other property in the immediate vicinity of the property which is the subject matter of this permit with respect to the purposes already permitted by these regulations, and
- 3. The conditional use permit and authorized uses thereunder will not substantially diminish or impair property values of existing properties in the neighborhood surrounding the property which is the subject matter of this permit, and
- 4. All necessary public facilities for use of the land subject to this permit are or will be available if the conditions for issuance are satisfied, and
- 5. The conditional use permit issued hereunder and the authorized uses under such permit will not impede the normal or orderly development or improvement of surrounding property for the uses permitted within the zoning district, and
- 6. The grant of this conditional use permit will not hinder the flow of traffic or result in traffic congestion on the public roads and that adequate access points to the subject property from public streets are available, and
- 7. The uses authorized by this conditional use permit are otherwise in conformity with the regulations pertaining to the zoning districts in which the uses are located and that there is a public necessity for the issuance of the conditional use permit hereunder.

The Commission, by authorizing issuance of the conditional use permit hereunder, further concludes as a matter of law that issuance of the permit is proper under the zoning regulations of Boone County in effect at the time of issuance and the general statutes and laws of this state.

## **Additional Findings:**

The County Commission further finds as fact in support of this conditional use permit the following to be true:

C.T. Wilson Family Trust is the owner of 35 acres of land located at the intersection of Academy Road and Caldwell Road, Boone County Missouri.

Green Valley Rifle and Pistol Club, Inc. (Green Valley) is a duly registered corporation with the State of Missouri.

Subject property was rezoned to REC (Recreation) by the Boone County Commission on 4/1/03.

Green Valley operates a firing range on adjoining property.

Access to the site is from Caldwell Road, a gravel, county maintained Road.

Existing land use in the area includes single family homes and agricultural land uses.

Public testimony provided at hearings conducted on 2/20/03 (Planning and Zoning Commission) and on 3/4/03 (County Commission) indicated that area residents hear shooting from the existing firing ranges for a distance of several miles. Witnesses testified that shots continue for long periods of time during the daylight hours and after dark on occasions. Witnesses testified that prolonged shooting detracts from the outdoor use and enjoyment of their property.

Representatives of Green Valley testified that the new firing range will provide shooting opportunities for members; rifle training for law enforcement and hunter safety course. Green Valley also testified that they plan to sponsor a number of shooting competition events throughout the year.

Public testimony stated that the County had recently paved the driving surface of Academy Road, but the improvements end at the existing firing range and do not extend to Caldwell Road. Caldwell Road is a narrow and unimproved county gravel road.

The conditions imposed under this permit are reasonable and necessary and are intended to minimize, control, and monitor sound transmission from the new firing range as it will affect use and enjoyment of surrounding property, are intended to promote public safety and convenience due to the proposed use as a firing range, and are intended to improve off-site public road infrastructure made necessary by the proposed use of the property.
