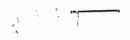

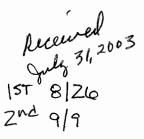

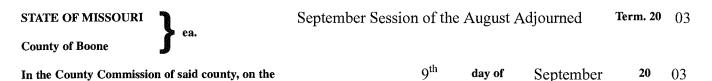

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The project includes mitigation of the storm drainage capacity problems / flooding in the roadside ditches and culverts along Andrews Lane. This project will be completed in two steps.

- A. The initial project includes reviewing the drainage on a basin wide basis and preparation of a report / master plan recommending specific improvements along Andrews Lane.
- B. The second phase, if authorized, includes design of specific improvements and preparation of drawings / project manual for bidding and construction.
