PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR

EMERGENCY ELECTRICAL SERVICES TERM AND SUPPLY

THIS AGREEMENT dated the 25 day of NOVENBER 2003 is made between Boone County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri through the Boone County Commission, herein "County" and Meyer Electric Company, Inc., herein "Contractor."

IN CONSIDERATION of the parties performance of the respective obligations contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Contract Documents This agreement shall consist of this Purchase Agreement for Emergency Electrical Services Term and Supply, County of Boone Request for Bid, bid number 72-18NOV03, Introduction and General Conditions of Bidding, Primary Specifications, Response Presentation and Review, the un-executed Response Form, Standard Terms and Conditions, as well as the Contractor's bid response dated November 18, 2003 and executed by Leon J. Keller on behalf of the Contractor. All such documents shall constitute the contract documents, which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Service or product data, specification and literature submitted with bid response may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office bid file for this bid if not attached. In the event of conflict between any of the foregoing documents, the Introduction and General Conditions of Bidding, Primary Specifications, Response Presentation and Review, the un-executed Response Form, and the Standard Terms and Conditions shall prevail and control over the Contractor's bid response.
- 2. Contract Duration This Term and Supply Contract will have an initial term from January 1, 2004 through December 31, 2004. After the initial term, this contract shall automatically renew each year for up to two (2) one-year renewal terms, unless canceled by the County upon written notice prior to the beginning of a renewal term. This agreement may be extended beyond the expiration date by order of the County, subject to the pricing clauses in the Contractor's bid response and thereafter on a month to month basis in the event the County is unable to re-bid and/or award a new contract prior to the expiration date after exercising diligent efforts to do so.
- 3. Purchase The County agrees to purchase from the Contractor and the Contractor agrees to supply the County Emergency Electrical Services as identified and responded to in the Contractor's Response Form. Items will be provided as required in the bid specifications and in conformity with the contract documents for the prices set forth in the Contractor's bid response, as needed and as ordered by the County.
- 4. Call Response Time Contractor agrees to respond one hour after notification by the County. Contractor agrees to provide the services as required by the bid specifications and as needed by the County of Boone.
- 5. Billing and Payment All billing shall be invoiced to the Boone County Facilities Maintenance Department, and may only include the prices as identified in the Contractor's bid response. No additional fees for delivery or extra services not included in the bid response or taxes shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in the Contractor's bid response to the specifications. The County agrees to pay all invoices within thirty days of receipt; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts offered in its bid response if county makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount; in the event the billing dispute is resolved in favor of the Contractor, the County agrees to pay interest at a rate of 9% per annum on disputed amounts withheld commencing from the last date that payment was due.

- 6. Binding Effect This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this agreement remains in full force and effect.
- 7. Entire Agreement This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and any other bid or bid specification or contractual agreement. This agreement may only be amended by a signed writing executed with the same formality as this agreement.
- 8. Termination This agreement may be terminated by the County upon thirty days advance written notice for any of the following reasons or under any of the following circumstances:

I have requested that there be a first reading tomorrow and a second on Tuesday of a budget revision to purchase a microfilm reader/printer. This is the piece of equipment that was originally purchased in 1992/93 and the company no longer can get parts for it or keep it on a service contract. We have had numerous service calls and down time. A couple of months ago when it failed, they advised us that it could no longer be fixed. At that time, they loaned us a piece of equipment so we would not be out of operation.

We went out on bid and based on Purchasing and our office reviewing the bids, we agree on the lowest bidder of Dynamic Solutions at a purchase cost of \$11,500.00 and a annual maintenance of \$1,100.00 plus any overage. We already have a annual service contract of \$1,500.00 budgeted. Rather than buy a separate printer to go with it, we bid it compatible with our copier at a lower copy cost.

This is an item we discussed in my budget review for next year that would come out based on this purchase. I included \$14,500 as a supplemental request for FY 2004. I am requesting that this budget revision be approved from GR Emergency Fund 1123-86800 to Recorder's Replace Office Equipment 1160-92000.
