Hold-on, Karen. The "OT hours" noted below are hours in excess of the regular 40 hours per week, but some of the hours were paid at straight time and some were paid at 1.5.

When it comes to law enforcement personnel, the OT rate (1.5) doesn't kick in at 40 hrs/wk as it does for other offices. (Please see section 4.2 of our personnel policy manual for the various FLSA classifications and a detailed explanation). In a nut shell: law enforcement OT is calculated on a 28-day cycle instead of a 7-day cycle. The OT rate (1.5) doesn't apply until hour 171 (rather than hour 160: 40/hrs/wk * 4 wks = 160). So, although an officer is working more than 40 hours per week, the OT premium rate (1.5) is only paid after the officer has worked 11 hours at straight time. June

Latest Model:

The contractor must provide 2011 model year or newer fleet passenger and cargo vans with all manufacturers' standard equipment and any additional equipment required by the State of Missouri. The base price on contract shall include all specifications stated herein.

All items of standard equipment which are normally provided with each vehicle by the manufacturer shall be furnished unless such items are expressly deleted or are specified to be other than standard.

All options and/or accessories stated herein must be manufacturer's original equipment. Aftermarket options and/or accessories shall not be acceptable.

As applicable, all options must be factory installed.

Warranty:
