#### DEPOSITORY TRANSITION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into effective the 1st day of August, 2011 by and between The County of Boone, State of Missouri (hereinafter referred to as "The County") and Landmark Bank of Columbia (hereinafter referred to as "The Bank").

WHEREAS, The County and The Bank have an existing Depository Agreement dated July 1, 2009 which was extended by an Extension Agreement effective July 1, 2011, (hereinafter the "2009 Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, The County notified The Bank, in compliance with the 2009 Agreement, that it intended to begin a new bidding process during 2011 for depository services and that the 2009 Agreement would not be extended for another two-year term; and

WHEREAS, The County desired to change the term of all future depository agreements to provide for a contract beginning date of September 1, which will allow a more thorough and complete evaluation of bank depository bid responses; and

WHEREAS, The County has completed its bidding process and intends to award the next County Depository contract to Boone County National Bank; and

WHEREAS, The County and The Bank desire to facilitate an orderly transition of all accounts and other banking services provided under the 2009 Agreement, on mutually agreeable terms and conditions; and

WHEREAS, the transition agreement would be on the same terms and conditions as the 2009 Agreement except as specifically modified herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The 2009 Agreement is incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth herein, including but not limited to, all contract documents, proposal responses from The Bank, exhibits and cost schedules.
- 2. The parties agree to continue to perform their respective duties and obligations under the 2009 Agreement, as to each specific account, until the Boone County Treasurer directs The Bank, in writing, that a specific account should be closed. All accounts will be closed no later than March 30, 2012.
- 3. Any checks being presented for payment to a Boone County account after that specific account has been closed pursuant to the direction of the Boone County Treasurer shall be dishonored by The Bank.

4. The Bank's services will be provided under the same terms and conditions of the 2009 Agreement except as modified in this Extension of Depository Agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this Depository Transition Agreement, and all incorporated documents, exhibits and schedules, are hereby executed in the name of The County by the Presiding Commissioner of the Boone County Commission, duly authorized pursuant to Commission Order Number <u>333</u>-2011, and in the name of The Bank by the officer duly authorized by the Board of Directors, as of the day and year indicated below.

September 1, 2011 – September 6, 2011

As Acting County Highway Administrator, and in consultation with the Boone County Sheriff's Department, it has been requested that the following roads be closed.

Oakland Gravel Rd--- south from Prathersville Rd to Brown School Rd

Starke Ave--entire road--Brown School Rd to Brown Station Rd

My recommendation for closure pertains only to the indicated roads which are maintained and controlled by the County.

Under the Boone County Traffic Regulations, the Commission may approve of the placement of traffic control devices placed by the decision of the County Highway Administrator. The County Counselor, C.J. Dykhouse, has recommended that the Commission expressly approve this plan as to the County-controlled roads by a Commission Order. For that reason, this is before the Commission for approval.

If the Commission approves of this plan, it is requested that the Deputy County Clerk furnish copies of the Commission Order to the following:
