- 2. Update Status of Outreach to Boone County School Districts
 - Status update on contact with Boone County superintendents
 Verna updated the group that emails went out this week requesting one on one meetings with Boone
 County District Superintendents and will schedule as they respond.
- 3. Addressing action steps beyond special services within the Strategy: Increase social/emotional/behavioral supports for children.
 - a. Help families feel comfortable seeking support (#4) There was a discussion addressing the needs of the learner in accessing the school/class technology at home and school device policies when they are damaged or lost. The workgroup discussed the upcoming Columbia Public Schools board meeting and the agenda item related to contract renewals on Title I Schools Reading Recovery programs with other school districts. This led to further discussion about programs and methods of teaching reading programs used across Boone County School Districts.
 - b. Coordinated/increase screenings (#7) The workgroup discussed different types of screenings being used and the varied terminology used. Suggestions for outreach efforts to increase screenings were discussed. Cindy Reese will assist in gathering information regarding the terms "screenings" and "assessments" and bring information back to the next workgroup meeting.
