

Early Grade Literacy Workgroup Minutes January 8, 2025, 2:30PM – 4:00PM

Meeting Objective: Develop a timeline for 2025 Early Grade Literacy Workgroup areas of focus and priority.

1. Welcome and Introductions

Al welcomed the group and opened the floor for introductions. The group welcomed Celina Castleman, who is a new attendee of the Early Grade Literacy Workgroup. Celina is the Children's Program Coordinator at True North.

2. Follow up from last meeting

The workgroup reviewed decisions made in the previous meeting to continue to meet on the second Wednesdays of each month from 2:30pm to 4:00pm at Central Missouri Community Action (CMCA) for the first quarter of 2025 and focus on four main priority areas to work on in 2025.

3. 2025 workgroup plan

The workgroup discussed the 2025 workgroup plan overview sheet which includes the four priority areas (Literacy Interventions, Waitlist Challenges, Screenings, and Technology Access Support), to determine where to start additional planning. Individuals shared different perspectives on where the workgroup could initially focus, noting things learned during previous workgroup meetings and efforts currently taking place.

The workgroup agreed to start with coordinating efforts around Literacy Interventions. Ideas for collaboration were shared, including information about previous community efforts, with the workgroup leaving the meeting intending to coordinate a community-wide literacy campaign. The workgroup aims to center this on early grade literacy with the understanding that engaging all ages in reading also benefits those learning to read.

Collaboration included noting additional planning would be necessary, with a timeline for the tasks and persons/organizations that are responsible for working towards that task still under development. The workgroup discussed available funding from Cradle to Career could be considered for the literacy campaign.

4. Next Steps

 Group members will brainstorm ideas for activities and events for the literacy campaign, both collaborative and within their own organizations.
