 - Ways of communicating to business partners to strengthen the outreach.
 - Ways that all the people at the table can help each other to grow their impact.
 - Organizations absent from the table and where they would fit.
 - Possibly splitting up the strategy based on the difference between middle school and high school efforts. Middle school should be knowledge focused and high school should be experience focused.
 - Some ideas that were brought by this brainstorming included: Memorandum of Understanding (MOUs), campaigning using student stories and stories of the key stakeholders, maintaining the 1:2:7 modern economics ratio, and connecting students with lived experience in their interested profession.
- b. (Action step #10) Expand opportunities for high school students to earn associate degrees for all Boone County schools.

- c. (Action Step #16) Identify and support youth earlier in their academic career to graduate or access alternative paths to high school graduation.
